## **Budget Report**

Mr. Sady reviewed the 4 accounts for band, their approximate balance, how money is raised for these accounts and what money is used for.

- Student Account
  - Approximate Current Balance: \$8,500
  - Source of Funds: Fees paid by students
  - Purpose: Used to pay for transportation, food, entry fees, instrument repairs, equipment, student assistants, etc.
- Booster Account
  - Approximate Current Balance: \$2,000
  - Source of Funds: fundraising activities such as door knocker, car washes, etc.
  - Purpose: used for spring band trip, transportation
- Spring Trip Account
  - Approximate Current Balance: \$0
  - Source of Funds: amount/cost for each student who goes on the spring trip
  - Purpose: used to pay for the spring trip expenses
- District Account
  - Approximate Current Balance: \$1,200
  - Source of Funds: funds that are provided through the school district
  - Purpose: used to purchase concert and jazz music

## **Spring Trip**

Mr. Sady provided a brief overview of the spring trip, noting that planning is still underway. Current plans are to travel to San Diego (March 15-18). If these dates are final, then Zone Concert will need to be moved.

## **Winter Concert**

Scheduled for 12/21 at Atlantis Casino. Some fundraising done here, but no entry fee.
